RESOLUTION CONCERNING DIVERSION
OF THE WATERS OF THE NAVAJO RIVER

WHEREAS, the Government is developing large areas of land for irrigation along the San Juan River in New Mexico for use of the Navajo tribe, be it resolved that the Government take the necessary steps to protect the water rights of the Indians.

WHEREAS, reports have been made for the diversion of the water of the Navajo River, a tributary of the San Juan, to the Rio Grande, be it further resolved that the Navajo Tribal Council are opposed to any such diversion which would impair the rights of the Navajo Indians to water from the San Juan River.
